## Price Comparison of Medical Procedures HIMAHEALTH vs. U.S. Mainland Hospitals

On average, HIMAHEALTH medical procedures cost 70 percent less than treatments in U.S. mainland facilities. The following charts compare the estimated costs for top medical procedures in HIMAHEALTH versus U.S. mainland prices for the same treatments.

### **Cardiovascular Procedures:**

Mitral Valve Replacement	Replacement of the inflow valve to the heart	<b>\$100K - \$160K</b>	<b>\$25K - \$35K</b>
Coronary Artery Bypass Surgery	Reduces risk of coronary heart disease and relieves chest pain from lack of blood reaching the heart	<b>\$80K - \$120K</b>	<b>\$25K - \$35K</b>

**Orthopedic Procedures:**

<b>Procedure</b>	<b>Common Purpose of Procedure</b>	<b>Average U.S. Mainland Cost</b>	<b>Average HIMAHEALTH Cost</b>
Total Hip Replacement	Damaged hip joint is replaced by prosthetic implant	<b>\$33K - \$64K</b>	<b>\$14K - \$18K</b>
Total Knee Replacement	Components of damaged knee joint are replaced by metal or plastic implants	<b>\$30K - \$59K</b>	<b>\$12K - \$16K</b>
Spinal Fusion	Combining two or more vertebrae due to shifting or damaged vertebrae	<b>\$52K - \$91K</b>	<b>(Case by case basis)</b>
Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) Reconstruction	Reconstruction of torn ACL often due to sports injury	<b>\$22K - \$46K</b>	<b>\$11K - \$15K</b>

**Oncology/Cancer Treatment:**

<b>Procedure</b>	<b>Common Purpose of Procedure</b>	<b>Average U.S. Mainland Cost</b>	<b>Average HIMAHEALTH Cost</b>
CyberKnife® (Radiosurgery)	Non-invasive radiosurgery; very precise and effective radiation treatment for cancer	<b>\$90K - \$120K (less than 5 treatments)</b>	<b>\$25- 35K (1-5 treatments)</b>

Urology Procedure (Prostatectomy, Nephrectomy, etc.)	da Vinci® Surgical System Robotic surgery of the male reproductive system and organs of the urinary tract.	<b>\$28,000 - \$39,000 (Not da Vinci®)</b>	<b>\$9K - \$12K (da Vinci®)</b>
